Dear Parents/Carers

Year group bubbles

Year groups are kept isolated from others during school day and we very pleased how well this has worked considering the age and number of children in our school.

Handwashing

This has been a key part of our daily routine. The children wash their hands when they arrive, after break times, before and after lunch, after toilet visits, before they go home and regularly throughout the day. This has become a normal part of school life for a number of months now and we will continue to maintain this level of cleanliness.

Catch it, bin it, kill it

The children are excellent at catching sneezes and runny noses in tissues and throwing them in the flip-top bin afterwards. They, of course, always wash their hands afterwards.

Drop-off and pick-up

Thank you for your cooperation this week. Arriving on time is the key to the system working properly and we are getting much better at it. Don't forget to collect your youngest child first and then follow the one way system at the end of the school day. The one way system means everyone is walking in the same direction and facing the same way which helps keep us all safe.

Can I just remind everyone to do your best to maintain a 1 metre + distance and step back or move away if you are too close. If you wish to wear a mask to drop off or at collection times that is fine.

May I also request that you do not huddle around the classroom and exit points. Please stand back from the doors keeping your distance from other parents.
