MyMaths

Children in year 2-6 are set MyMaths homework.

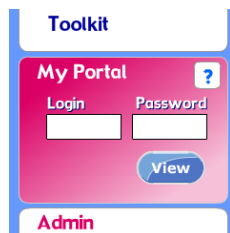
This is accessible via:

Step 1: log in to the school's site, using **login:** bedfont **password:** yellow



Step 2: log into 'my portal' for your child's own page, using their unique login details.



Homework at Key Stage One

- Mymaths - This will appear automatically in your child's 'my portal' page.
- Reading - please read with your child, 15 minutes per day where possible; they will bring home library and reading scheme books. Books are set on Bug Club according to your child's reading ability.
- Penpals handwriting task.
- IXL Maths, on trial in Y1.
- At year 2, IPC project tasks will also be set.

Homework at Key Stage Two

- Mymaths - This will appear automatically in your child's 'my portal' page.
- In year 6, children will have 'SATs Buster' homework set, which will sometimes replace MyMaths tasks.
- Reading - please read with your child, 15 minutes per day where possible. Books are set on Bug Club according to your child's reading ability. Additionally, years 4-6 have 'Accelerated Reader' access, to help with reading comprehension.
- IPC project tasks will be set - this will vary by topic.

Homework is set on a Friday and due in the following week. Please make sure that your children speak to their teacher as soon as possible if they have any questions or problems with their homework!
